VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) volunteers are certified by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) to prepare the 1040EZ, 1040A, and simple 1040 tax returns along with Arkansas State Return.

For Families and Individuals earning less than \$54,000 a year

The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program offers free tax assistance to people who generally make \$54,000 or less, persons with disabilities and limited English speaking taxpayers who need assistance in preparing their own tax returns.

MCAEOC began the VITA program in 2009 serving close to 200 clients. Over the years Mississippi County Arkansas EOC has serviced 3,776 clients during the January thru April tax season. MCAEOC currently has seven volunteers to serve the Mississippi County Area.
