Please bring the following items:

Social Security Cards for yourself, spouse and all dependents being claimed

Photo ID

All income statements: Forms W-2 and 1099, Social Security, unemployment, **Health Insurance Marketplace Statement**, and other statements, such as pensions, stocks, interest and any documents showing taxes withheld. If self-employed or your own or run a business, bring records of all your income.

All records of expenses, such as tuition, mortgage interest, or real estate taxes. If self-employed or you own or run a business, bring records of all your expenses.

A copy of last year's tax return

Bank routing & account numbers for direct deposit

Dependent child care information: name and address of who you paid and either the caretaker's SSN or other tax identification number.

Both spouses to sign forms to e-file your joint tax return.

Any other information that would help us prepare your return
